

# BadgerSoft ABC Topic List — Security & Privacy

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## How it works

BadgerSoft ABC Topic List is a standard SharePoint Framework (SPFx) client-side web part. It reads items from a SharePoint list selected by the page editor and displays them as an alphabetical (A-Z) overview with a configurable detail view. It uses the SharePoint REST API through PnPjs, running under the current user's existing session and permissions.

All code and assets are bundled inside the .sppkg package — nothing is loaded from external sources at runtime.

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## Permissions

This web part requires **no additional permissions** beyond what comes standard with SPFx:

- No Microsoft Graph API permissions
- No Azure AD app registration
- No `webApiPermissionRequests` in the solution manifest
- No admin consent prompts during deployment

Tenant admins can verify this: the App Catalog will show zero API permission requests for this package.

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## Data handling

Topic	Details
Data read	SharePoint list items (including configured detail fields and attachments), column metadata, and site theme — all via the standard SharePoint REST API
Data written	None — the web part is read-only
Data stored	Configuration is stored in the web part's standard property bag on the page
User data collected	None
Telemetry / analytics	None
Cookies / local storage	None

The web part operates within SharePoint's standard permission model. Users only see list items they already have access to.

When a Person field is configured in the detail view, the web part loads user photos from the standard SharePoint endpoint (`/_layouts/15/userphoto.aspx`). This is an internal SharePoint URL — no third-party photo service is contacted.

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## External connections

The web part makes **one** external call, and only in a specific scenario:

What	When	Data sent
License validation via BadgerSoft proxy (Azure Functions, West Europe)	Only when a page editor opens the property pane	Tenant ID + product identifier

This call is **not made** during normal page viewing. No user data, list content, site URLs, or other tenant information is included.

If the license proxy is unreachable, the web part continues to function normally.

## User-initiated links

Some configurable display options produce hyperlinks that the **end user** may click. These are not automatic network calls — the browser only navigates when the user actively clicks:

Feature	Destination
<b>Location</b> field with map link	<a href="https://www.google.com/maps/search/?api=1&amp;query=...">https://www.google.com/maps/search/?api=1&amp;query=...</a> (only when the user clicks the address)
<b>Profile click behavior — Custom link</b>	The URL pattern configured by the page editor (e.g. an internal HR system)
<b>Items with a direct link</b>	The URL stored in the configured Hyperlink column (per item)

## Deployment

Setting	Value
skipFeatureDeployment	true — tenant-wide or per-site, admin's choice
includeClientSideAssets	true — all assets inside the package
isDomainIsolated	false — standard for SPFx web parts that read list data

Deployment requires only a SharePoint admin with App Catalog access. No Azure AD admin, Global admin, firewall changes, or service accounts needed.
